### **Dogs Eligible to Enter**

This event is open to all dogs classified as Miscellaneous or are an approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) dog, four (4) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club. No Champions of Record may compete in an Open Show. No spade or neutered dogs. Professional handlers are not permitted to exhibit in Open Shows, **with the exception of dogs of which they are the recorded owner/co-owner.** Professional handlers are defined according to the *Rules applying to Dog Shows*, Chapter 3 Section 7.

Dogs should be physically sound. No dog shall be judged if it is taped, bandaged, glued or stitched anywhere including ears or tail in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

### **SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY**

**The safety of dogs and people are** our primary concern. By entering this event, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport. **It is expressly understood** that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog and /or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the event committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The Greenwich Kennel Club and the Longshore-Southport Kennel Club and their agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers or to any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children. The Greenwich Kennel Club and the Longshore-Southport Kennel Club reserve the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against either organization or any official thereof. **All dogs must be on leash** at all times when on event grounds. No retractable leads, electronic or prong collars, please.

### **Refunds**

**No entry fee** will be refunded if the event cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committees. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent disqualified, excused or barred from competition by the action of the Show Committees.

### **Ringside**

**Dogs should arrive** a minimum of one half hour prior to judging. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused. **Judges are not required** to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Clubs have no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

### **Site Information**

**Exhibitors are responsible** for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if a Show Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Disposal sites will be available at the various locations around the show grounds.

### **How to Use the Entry Blank**

Use one entry blank per dog only if information is exactly the same for each event. Carefully check the block for each event in which you wish to enter your dog. You must use a separate entry blank if you are entering your dog in a different class.

### **OVERSIZED VEHICLES (12' - 14' clearance)**

Rte. I-95, Exit #16. Go South on East Ave. Prior to railroad overpass, turn right onto Fort Point St. to 2nd stop sign. Pass under the overpass (14' clearance). Proceed straight to traffic light turning left onto Seaview Ave. Follow Seaview to First St. Turn right at the traffic light onto Gregory Blvd. See above.

When you return Sycamore St. is on the right opposite First Street at this Gregory Blvd. traffic light.

### **FDR PARK TO RTE. 7 CONNECTOR AND I-95 NORTH**

To avoid I-95 traffic, back roads 30 miles - 40 minutes.

Take Rte. 202 South to Rte. 35 East towards Ridgefield, CT. Follow to the "Y" (Rte. 33) at the Ridgefield fountain. Go right (South) onto Rte. 33. Follow Rte. 33 to traffic light at end and Rte 7. Turn right (South) and follow Rte. 7 for approximately 4 miles. In Norwalk Rte. 7 becomes "Main Ave." Turn right at light just past Starbucks (on right). At the 2nd set of lights turn left onto the "Rte. 7 Connector" (South). At the end, take I-95 North over the bridge. Take Exit #16 and see above.

### **I-84 in CT. TO I-95**

Take Exit #3 (Rte. 7) South for about 17 miles. In Norwalk Rte. 7 becomes "Main Ave." Turn right at light just past Starbucks (on right). At 2nd set of lights, go left onto "Rte. 7 Connector" to I-95 North to next exit (#16). See above.

I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. - (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. - A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name.
