Professional handlers are defined according to the Rules applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 3 Section 7.

Dogs should be physically sound. No dog shall be judged if it is taped, bandaged, glued or stitched anywhere including ears or tail in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

Refunds
