This event is open to all dogs classified as Miscellaneous or are an approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) dog, four (4) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club. No Champions of Record may compete in an Open Show. No spayed or neutered dogs. Professional handlers are not permitted to exhibit in Open Shows, with the exception of dogs of which they are the recorded owner/co-owner. Professional handlers are defined according to the *Rules applying to Dog Shows*, Chapter 3 Section 7. Dogs should be physically sound. No dog shall be judged if it is taped, bandaged, glued or stitched anywhere including ears or tail in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

#### OWNERS/EXHIBITORS OF FOREIGN REGISTERED DOGS

If you are the owner/exhibitor of a dog registered with a foreign registry (not yet dual registered with AKC) please review the eligibility requirements in The Rules Applying to Dog Shows, chapter 11 section 1. The dog show rules are posted on the AKC Web site at: http://images.akc.org/pdf/rulebooks/RREGS3.pdf Most important to note are the following: 1. Dogs must be individually registered with the American Kennel Club by the day of the event to be eligible for exhibit in the Bred by Exhibitor class. 2. That 30-day period begins with the date of first exhibit, regardless of whether the dog earned any points or awards.
